

Mullaway School Uniform Expectations

Mullaway Primary School aims to foster a sense of pride in our school and the wearing of our school uniform contributes to this sense of pride. Students are encouraged to take pride in themselves and their personal appearance. Our expectations require all students to wear a clean, neat and tidy uniform correctly at all times, both on school grounds and when outside of school. Our Uniform expectations have been developed in consultation with students, staff and parents and takes into consideration the Cancer Council of Australia recommendations. Mullaway Primary School appreciates and expects parents and carers support in this matter. The NSW Department of Education Uniform Policy (https://education.nsw.gov.au/policy-library/policies/pd-2004-0025) states:

- The department requires that schools set local school uniform requirements.
- The department supports the wearing of school uniform, which promotes a sense of belonging for students and creates a positive identity for the school community. School uniforms also contribute to the personal safety of students by allowing easier recognition of students inside the school and in the community.
- Schools expect students to wear the uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when engaged in school activities out of school hours.

Mullaway Primary School Uniform expectations are as follows:

Modest length -(half-way between the top of the leg and knee.) When standing straight the tip of the middle finger is where the bottom of the clothing should be.

REPRESENTATIVE AND LEADERSHIP ROLES When representing Mullaway PS or in a Leadership role the expectation is to dress in the correct uniform. SRC students and parents sign an agreement when accepting a leadership role which states this in the agreement. This includes wearing shorts, skirts, or skorts at a modest length. A Mullaway school blazer is available to all students when needed for more formal events (eg) Presentation Day assemblies, ANZAC Day Marches, Debating, Public Speaking, etc.



<u>SPORTS CARNIVALS</u> – Mullaway holds 4 sporting carnivals a year-Swimming, Cross Country, Athletics and Mullaball Cup/Tug-a-war. All children are encouraged to wear house colours on these days. Appropriate clothing and shoes for each event are encouraged. (eg) joggers for running events, swimmers, rash shirt and goggles for swimming events, etc. House shirts are also available to be purchased through the Mullaway School P&C.

ACCESSORIES - head bands or ribbons—plain black, white or teal.

BIKE PANTS - can be worn under skirts/tunic and on sports days/carnivals.

JEWELLERY- the 1 rule - a maximum of one necklace, one bracelet, one anklet.

No dangly earrings. Sleepers or studs.

All jewellery items are to be discreet.

No make up is allowed to be worn to school.

No False Finger Nails to be worn to school.

Wearing the correct school uniform is an expectation at Mullaway.

Students who do not wear the correct jumper will be required to do a day-swap of their non-school jacket for one of our School jackets. (our jackets are identified by the white "M" symbol on the back).
