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




Combined Rotary and Mullaway PS Project

Attendance Matters



Late Arrivals & Whole Day Absences

At Mullaway Primary School, we have opted to use SMS as a communication tool to notify of absences for both late arrivals and whole day absences. This is a legal requirement of schools.

Our school day begins at 8.55am, so any student who arrives after the 8.55am bell needs to report to the office to sign in and a partial absence SMS will be sent home to parent/carer requesting an explanation. Any student who is marked absent by the classroom teacher after roll call (by 9.30am) is deemed

as a whole day absence and a SMS message will be sent to the parent/carer to inform them of their child's' non-attendance and requesting an explanation. If you have any concerns that your child should be at school and you receive an SMS saying they are not present, please contact the school immediately on (02) 6654 0377.



Why is this necessary you might ask? It is a requirement of the government that all school age children attend school and non-attendance requires explanation whether it is 1 min late to full day/s absence/s. In addition to this, absences that are longer than 3 days in duration require formal documentation (medical certificate) or explanation to be reviewed by the principal to determine justified/unjustified leave, all other leave is deemed as unjustified and if this drops students below the 90% required attendance mark in NSW Public Schools, additional measures will be asked of parents/carers to assist in improving the students attendance. This could be through developing a plan made in collaboration with the school.

In cases where attendance doesn't improve, the Home School Liaison Office (HSLO) will be notified and a Student Attendance Improvement Plan (SAIP) can be required and developed in consultation with the HSLO. This SAIP will need to be adhered too and is monitored for a period of time before further, potentially legal, avenues may be sought to improve the student's attendance.

At Mullaway, we value your child's attendance at school and their contributions in the classroom and the connections they make with their peers and teachers. If at any time you need advice or assistance regarding any matters of attendance you can contact the school and request a call back from one of the attendance team members or your child's classroom teacher. It is important you know we are here to help; open lines of communication are vital to ensure we are working together to maintain and/or improve the attendance of the students at MPS to produce the quality contributors to society we aim to develop.

Absences Whole Days



Frequently asked

Does the approved free travel include travel outside school hours?

Approved free school travel is only for travel to and fre school. So for travel after hours, on weekends or durin school holidays, students will need to buy a ticket. What if there's no public transport in my are

How do I apply if the student needs to tra from two addresses because the parents I separately?

Each parent (or the student if aged 16 or over) needs to apply separately for each address. The same minimum distances apply.

How to apply for free travel for the first time

You can apply for free school travel for ne year from the start of Term 4 this year.

A parent or guardian must apply for students aged 15 years and under. Students who are 16 years and must apply for themselves.

Saver Plus is a free ten month savings program that provides financial education and matches your savings up to \$500 for educational expenses.

Can you join?

To be eligible to join Saver Plus you must:

- be 18 years or over;
- be a parent or guardian of a student attending school, or be attending vocational education yourself;
- have a current Health Care card or Pensioner Concession card;
- be receiving a Centrelink benefit, allowance or payment;
- have some form of regular income from work (you or your partner) OR receive child support;
- not have completed SaverPlus before.
